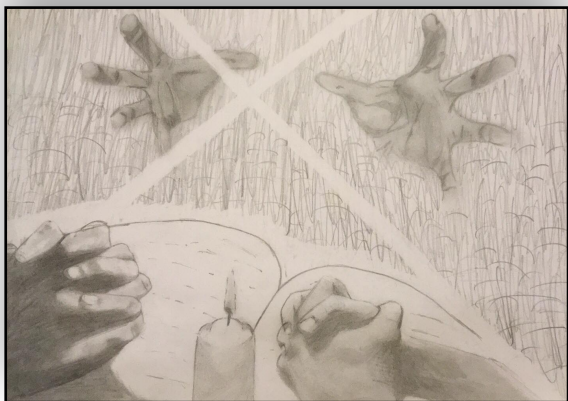
This is Kenji and Kiho with our Pastor, Toshikazu Haruta. This was taken right after they were baptized in October!
