October Spiritual Exercise:

1. Read and meditate on such passages as Psalm 103:1-5 and Ephesians 1:7-8. Meditate on God's forgiveness of your sins through Christ Jesus. You may want to write some of your sins on paper, and then ponder how through Jesus Christ those sins have been forgiven.
2. Read and meditate on Matthew 18:21-35. With the forgiveness you have received, pass that forgiveness onto others. Are there people you need to forgive? You may want to write them down and then ceremonially shred or burn them as a sign of your forgiveness. As directed by the Holy Spirit, you may also need to go and talk with that person to attempt to bring wholeness to that relationship.

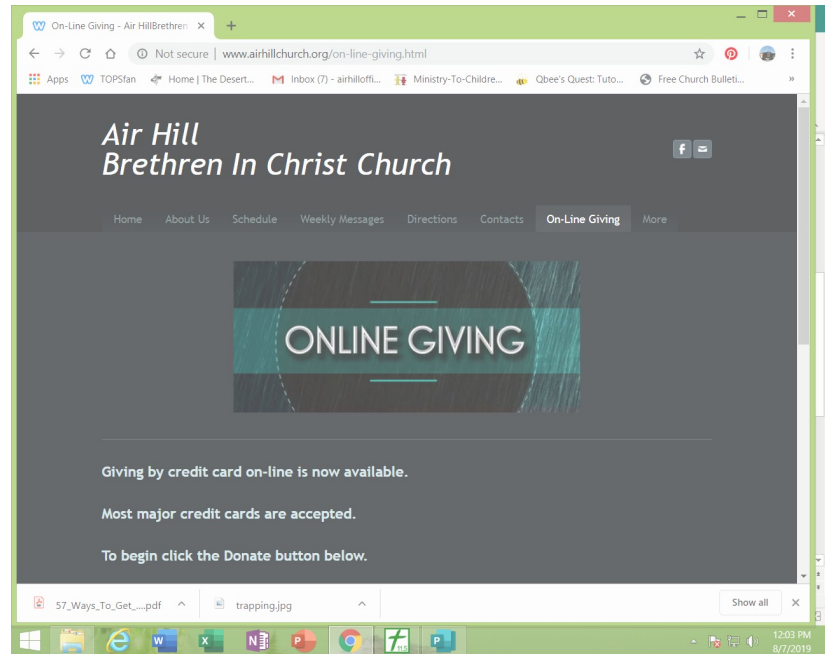

"That's right son, why?"

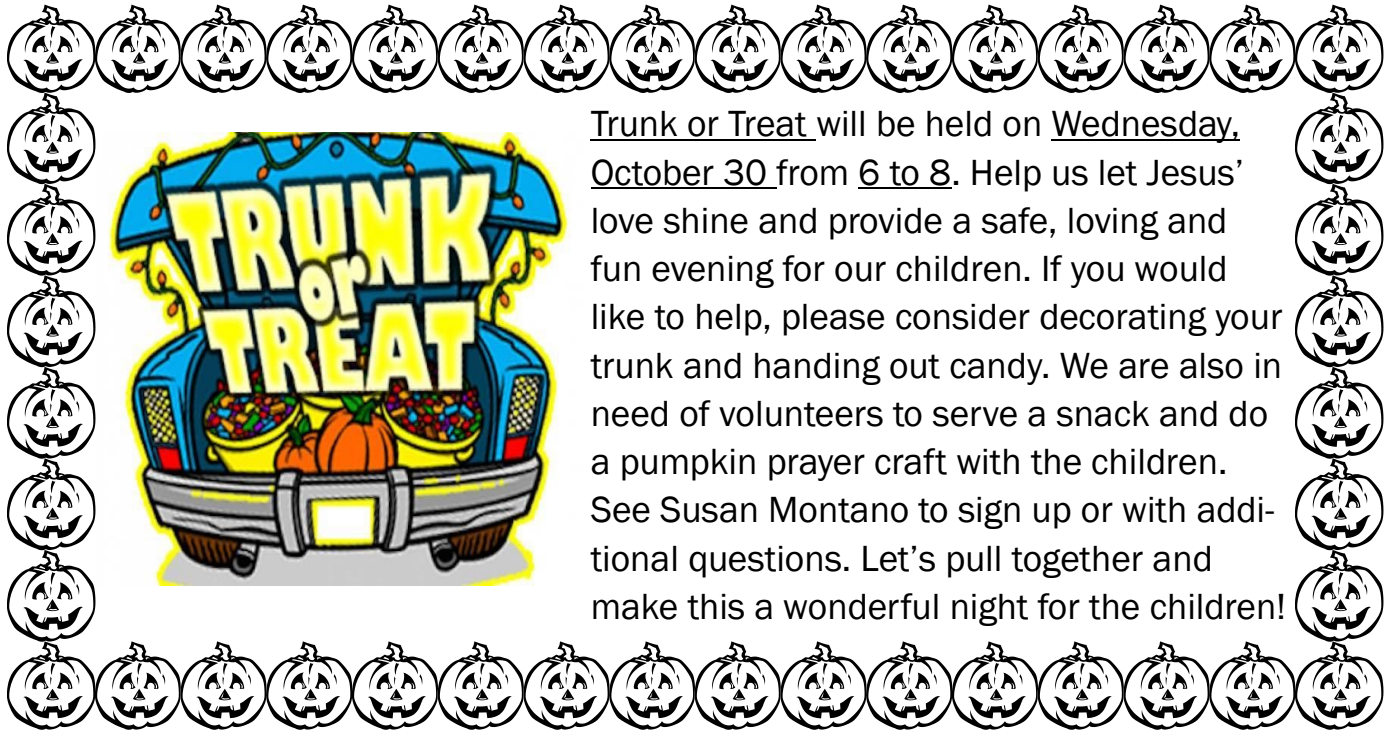
"Well that's just what they said at church today."
